

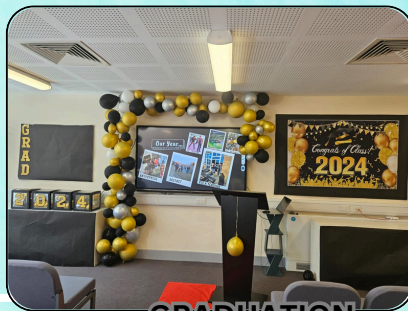


Our enterprise qualifications are what we use to help our pupils prepare for work, with the intention of showing what it takes to run a business.

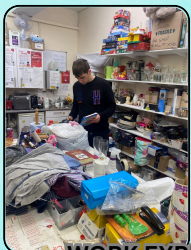
